A message from Chief Financial Officer and Vice Chancellor Ronald S. Cortez



Dear DFA employees,

As you may have seen from Chancellor Gillman's recent message, UCI is taking definitive actions in light of the uncertainty surrounding COVID-19. While there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 within the UCI community at this time, these decisions are made in support of the concept of "social distancing," which is a public health concept to reduce the probability of contact between individuals who are or may be carrying a highly contagious disease. Social distancing – which can be effective with as little as a six-feet gap between individuals – helps to prevent infections that are transmitted by droplet (such as coughing, sneezing, or touching a contaminated surface).

I would like to take the opportunity to reiterate some of the key points from the Chancellor's message:

- All events and gatherings with more than 100 participants are to be canceled. Where
  possible, you are encouraged to deliver the event in an alternative format. For campus events
  that continue as scheduled, it is advised that organizers exercise key prevention strategies in
  event operation plans. At this time, our spring town hall will not be scheduled.
- Campus offices will remain open. Employees who need to work remotely should contact
  supervisors for guidance and approval. Assistant Vice Chancellor David Ott is leading our
  division's business continuity planning efforts. As announced in <a href="Chief Griffin's email">Chief Griffin's email</a> over the
  weekend, your participation in the Business Continuity Program is essential in this
  preparation as it will help you update and/or develop your plans, not only for this event, but for
  any possible future event that may interrupt business operations.
- UCI is restricting all non-essential university-sponsored travel international or domestic, particularly by air or train. Any UCI sponsored travel by DFA employees will require my approval. You are encouraged to find alternate means of conducting business as we work to help limit the potential spread of infection to other areas.

I would like to thank each of you, our staff, who truly are the backbone of the enterprise that is UCI – a top global university by many measures – your dedication to support campus operations does not go unnoticed. We are experiencing unprecedented events, things are evolving quickly, and we appreciate your commitment and partnership during this time. I am meeting regularly with my cabinet members who are all working together to prepare the campus for various scenarios and actions related to COVID-19.
